A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY (AGENCY) APPROVING THE SELECTION OF ARCHITECTURAL FIRM CORZO, CASTELLA, CARBALLO, THOMPSON AND SALMAN P.A. (C3TS), OF BOCA RATON, FLORIDA AND THE ARCHITECTURAL FIRM, SONG AND ASSOCIATES OF WEST PALM BEACH FLORIDA, UTILIZING THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH RFP PROCESS (RFP-276-10) TO PROVIDE CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL ARCHITECTURAL AND PLANNING CONSULTING SERVICES FOR A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Riviera Beach (City) published a request for qualifications for two separate and distinct groups of professional services: Group 1- General Civil Engineering, Traffic Engineering and Group 2 Architectural, Structural Engineering, Electrical Engineering, and Mechanical Engineering, RFQ 276-10; and

WHEREAS, RFQ 276-10 included the scope of architectural/design redevelopment, renovations and/or new architectural plans for projects that are authorized within the redevelopment area; and

WHEREAS, the City's selection committee evaluated and ranked proposals after a thorough Request for Qualifications process, and selected two firms to provide the services identified in the City's RFQ 276-10, namely: Corzo, Castella, Carballo, Thompson and Salman, P. A. (C3TS), and Song and Associates; and

WHEREAS, the Riviera Beach Community Redevelopment Agency (Agency) is responsible for carrying out community redevelopment activities and projects within its boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the Agency would like to "piggyback" on the City's RFQ process for architectural/design redevelopment, renovations, and/or new architectural plans, since the City has already established and utilized a process that complies with all applicable statutory processes to select a qualified architectural/design firm to provide these services; and

WHEREAS, the staff of the Agency recommends that the Agency to provide continuing professional architectural and planning consulting services for a period of three years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE RIVIERA BEACH COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY THAT:

SECTION 1 The Community Redevelopment Agency authorizes the selection of Corzo, Castella, Carballo, Thompson and Salman, P. A. (C3TS), and Song and Associates for a period of three years for continuing professional architectural and planning consulting services. The Executive Director is hereby authorized to prepare an Interlocal agreement between the City of Riviera Beach and the Agency to coordinate development of the Marine District South utilizing the professional architectural and planning consulting services, and to issue payments from the appropriate fund as indicated in the FY 2010-2011 CRA Budget to pay for the professional architectural and planning consulting services.

SECTION 2. Should any one or more of the provisions of this Resolution or Exhibit be held invalid, such provision shall be null and void, and shall be deemed separate from the remaining provisions and shall in no way affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of the Resolution.

SECTION 3. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.



SUMMARY: These continuing services contracts will allow the City to move forward with any architectural/design redevelopment, renovations or new architectural plans that are authorized for projects in the redevelopment area and/or projects that are included in the 5 year capital plan by providing architectural and planning services for projects that have an estimated construction budget of less than 2 million dollars. These contracts are intended to be utilized by both the City and the CRA by way of an Interlocal Agreement.

BACKGROUND: In accordance with the City of Riviera Beach Procurement Code (Ordinance 2412) and consistent with **Florida Statute 287.055** a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) was advertised in the "Legal Notices" section of the Palm Beach Post on **August 8, 2010** to solicit qualified firms to provide Professional Engineering, Architectural and Planning Consulting Services.

The RFQ solicited scope of services for two separate and distinct groups of professional services: Group 1 - General Civil Engineering, Traffic Engineering, Planning Consulting Services, Land Surveying and Geotechnical Engineering and Group 2-Architectural, Structural Engineering, Electrical Engineering, and Mechanical Engineering

On November 19, 2010, an evaluation committee consisting of the City of Riviera Beach Engineering Technician, Interim Public Works Director, Utility District Engineer, and Senior Procurement Specialist convened to review and discuss the responses to the city's RFQ for Professional Engineering, Architectural and Planning Consulting Services.

Consistent with the requirements of **Florida Statute 287.055**, the consultant competitive negotiation act these firms were evaluated and ranked based on the criteria established in the city's RFQ which included the following considerations:

1. **DEMONSTRATED CAPACITY TO COMPLETE PROJECTS ON TIME AND WITHIN BUDGET CONSTRAINTS.**
2. **QUALITY AND EXTENT OF PRIOR EXPERIENCE WITH SIMILAR ASSIGNMENTS/PROJECTS AND RELATED SERVICES WITHIN LAST FIVE (5) YEARS.**
3. **AVAILABILITY, EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE OF STAFF TO BE ASSIGNED TO PERFORM REQUIRED ASSIGNMENTS.**
4. **MINORITY/WOMEN BUSINESS ENTERPRISE PARTICIPATION GOAL ACHIEVED.**
5. **LOCATION OF FIRM.**

On December 1, 2010, the three (3) short-listed firms were invited to give oral presentations before the committee to discuss their method and approach to quality control; the fast tracking of assigned tasks; prior experience with public-sector clients; processes/methods for successful execution of similar assignments; and the availability of their firms.

Committee members evaluated each oral presentation and scored each according to **interaction, presentation and ability to communicate technical information**. Finally, total average scores for both written proposals and oral presentations were combined and tallied. Accordingly, the committee ranks the short-listed firms Group 2- Architectural Services as follows:

(C3TS) of Boca Raton and Song and Associates of West Palm Beach.

C3TS is a minority owned and operated multi-disciplinary architectural and engineering consulting business based out of Boca Raton, Florida. The firm has substantial experience in providing the types of services identified in the City's RFQ.




